

Ordinance No. 45.

An ordinance repealing certain portions of an ordinance entitled, "An ordinance to authorize the erection, construction and operation of a system of water works in the Town of Grand Junction, for the extinguishment of fires, sanitary, domestic and other purposes, granting to N. J. Krusen, his associates, successors and assigns the right to construct and operate the same, and contracting with said Krusen, his associates, successors and assigns, for fire hydrants." Adopted November 23, 1888.

Whereas, the said N. J. Krusen, named in said ordinance, his associates, successors and assigns, have at all times wholly failed to comply with the conditions, stipulations and requirements

contained in said ordinance, on their part to be performed: Now therefore,

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction,

That sections three (3), four (4), six (6), eleven (11) and twelve (12), of said above entitled ordinance, adopted November 23rd, 1888, and any and all other portions of said ordinance purporting to contract with said Krusen, his associates, successors and assigns for fire hydrants or hydrant metal, be and the same are hereby repealed.
