

## Ordinance No. 51.

The annual appropriation bill for the fiscal year, beginning April 1st, 1896, and ending March 31st, 1897.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

That the following sums of money be, and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying all necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning the first day of April A. D. 1896, and ending the 31st day of March A. D. 1897, to-wit :

| 8th—For the general fund.....  | 4000 00   |
