An Ordinance Concerning Fowls:

Be it ordained by the City Council of the city of Grand Junction: Section I No chickens, geese, ducks, turkers, or other fowls shall be permitted to rub, or be at large, within the limits of the city of Grand Junction, at any time. And any person being the owner of any such towis, who shall suffer the s me to run, or be at large, contrary to the provisions of this section, shall be deemed the author of a buisarce, and shall on con viction, be fined in the sum of not I-ss than two, nor more than twenty five ollars in each case.
