

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 53.

BE IT ORDAINED by the city council of the city of Grand Junction, Colorado, that the following sums of money be and the same are, hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying all necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning the first day of April, 1897 and ending the thirty-first day of March 1898, to-wit:

1st.—For the purpose of maintaining a police force, the sum of \$2,000

2nd.—For the purpose of maintaining, improving and repairing parks, streets, alleys, avenues, crossings, sidewalks and ditches; lighting streets and alleys and public buildings and providing for irrigation purposes, the sum of \$4,000

3rd.—For the purpose of maintaining a fire department, the sum of \$1,200

4th.—For the purpose of paying fees and salaries other than those of police officers, the sum of..... \$4,200

5th.—For the general fund, the sum of..... \$3,500
