1st.—For the purpose of maintaining a police force, the sun of \$2,000 2nd.—For the purpose of main-

taining, improving and repairing parks, streets, alleys, avenues, crossings, sidewalks and ditches; lighting streets and alleys and public buildings and providing for irrigation purposes, the sum of \$4,000 ard.—For the purpose of main-

taing a fire department, the sum of \$1,200
