ORDINANCE No. 64.

An Ordinance to Amend Section No. 2 of Article No. 2 of Ordinance No. 19, Passed September 26th, 1891.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction:

Ordinance No. 19 be, and the same is hereby

amended to read as follows:

SEC. 2. Any person, firm or association who desire to carry on a plumbing business in this city, may procure a license to conduct such business, lay pipes and make connections with water mains, by making application therefor to the city council, which application shall be accompanied by a bond in the penal sum of \$500, with two or more sufficient sureties, to be approved by the city council, payable to the City of Grand Junction; and conditioned, that said applicant will faithfully observe all ordinances of the city concerning plumbing, and will faithfully pay any and all damages for which the city may become liable, or which may be sustained by any person or persons by reason of any negligence, carelessness or unskillfulness in the performance of any plumbing or in connection therewith within said City of Grand Junction. Which said bond may be sued upon by said city in its corporate capacity or by any person, company or corporation sustaining any such damage in the name of said city for the use of the person so damaged.

Upon the filing of such application and bond, and the approval thereof by the city council, and the payment into the city treasury by such applicant of a license fee of Five Dollars, such license shall issue for the term of one year; and it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to engage in the business of plumbing within this city without first procuring such license; provided that such parties shall obtain the written consent of the mayor before excavating in any of the streets or alleys of this city, as in other

cases.

Any violation of this ordinance shall be punished according to the terms and provisions of Section 6 of Article II of said Ordinance No. 19.
