

ORDINANCE No. 71.

Annual Appropriation Ordinance.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado:

That the following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the city of Grand Junction for the fiscal year beginning April 1st, 1898, and ending March 31st, 1899, to-wit:

FIRST—For the purpose of maintaining a police force.....\$2500 00

SECOND—For the purpose of maintaining, proving and repairing streets, alleys, avenues, crossings, sidewalks, ditches and public parks.....\$2500 00

THIRD:—For lighting streets, alleys, avenues and public buildings, and for irrigation purposes.....\$1500 00

FOURTH:—For maintaining the fire department.....\$ 500 00

FIFTH:—For fees and salaries other than police officers.....\$4500 00

SIXTH:—For the general fund of the city...\$3000 00
