

ORDINANCE No. 73.

An Ordinance to Repeal Ordinance No. 70.

*Be It Ordained By the City Council of the
City of Grand Junction, Colorado:*

That Ordinance No. 70, passed and adopted March 8, 1898, and entitled "An ordinance to contract an indebtedness on the behalf of the City of Grand Junction by the issuance of its bonds in the sum of fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000) for the purchase of the Grand Junction Water Company's plant and system of water works now in operation in said city, the same to be forever owned and operated by the said city for the purpose of supplying the said city and its inhabitants with water for fire and domestic purposes," be and the same is hereby repealed.
