

# ORDINANCE NO. 80.

## An Ordinance Concerning Bawdy Houses.

*Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City  
of Grand Junction, State of Colorado:*

SECTION 1. No bawdy house, house of ill-fame, house of assignation or place for the practice of fornication, or common ill-governed or disorderly house, shall be kept or maintained within the city of Grand Junction, nor within three miles of the outer boundaries thereof; and no person shall keep any such house in this city nor be an inmate thereof nor in any way connected therewith. No person shall in this city permit any tenement, building, or premises in his, her or their control, either as owner or agent, to be used for any such purpose aforesaid. Nor shall any such ground be leased or occupied for any such purpose within this city.

SEC. 2. No person shall contribute to the support of any bawdy house, house of ill-fame, house of assignation or place for the practice of fornication within this city. Nor shall any person become a frequenter of any such house, nor be found in or in any way connected with any such place.

SEC. 3. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined in any sum not less than fifteen (\$15) dollars not more than one hundred (\$100) dollars for each offence.
