

Grand Junction, Colorado, May 25, 1915.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Vorbeck, Rankin, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioner Carson.

The minutes of the regular meeting of May 18 were read and approved.

The petition of Chas. S. Turner and others, asking the Commissioner of Highways to construct a feet bridge across the Grand Valley irrigation canal on North Seventh street, was presented and read.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the petition was referred to the Commissioner of Highways, with power to act.

John J. Allison tendered his resignation as an officer of the Police department, to take effect on June 1st, 1915.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the resignation of Mr. Allison be accepted.

The motion carried by a unanimous vote of the Commissioners present.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the Council adjourned.
