

Grand Junction, Colorado
June 16, 1915.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at 11 o'clock a. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington presiding.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Cherrington, Vorbeck, Rankin, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioner Carson.

A proposed agreement between the U. S. Secretary of Agriculture and the City of Grand Junction, providing for the co-operative supervision of the water shed of Kannah Creek, for the purpose of preventing contamination of the water of said district, dated June 15, 1915, was read and discussed.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the said agreement be entered into with the Secretary of Agriculture, and that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to execute the same on behalf of said city under the seal thereof.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Rankin, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

On motion of Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, the Council then adjourned.
