

Grand Junction, Colorado, June 22, 1915.

The reports of the City Weigher for the months of April and May having been examined and approved by the Mayor, the same were on motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, accepted and ordered placed on file.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the Council adjourned until to-morrow, June 23, at four o'clock p. m.
