

Grand Junction, Colorado
January 7, 1916

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at 2 o'clock p.m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Cherrington, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioner Carson.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

Commissioner Vorbeck introduced a proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Providing for the Issue by the City of Grand Junction, in the State of Colorado, of its Negotiable Interest Bearing Bonds, to be designated Grand Junction Funding Bonds, Series of January First, 1916, in the aggregate amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), for the purpose of Funding and Redeeming a like amount of the outstanding Legal Warrants of the City and the Indebtedness Evidenced Thereby;" which ordinance was thereupon read in full by the Clerk.

It was thereupon moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that said ordinance be ordered published in The Daily News, a newspaper printed and published and of general circulation in the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, in its issue of January 8, 1916, and that said ordinance be considered for final passage at the regular meeting of the City Council, to be held not less than ten days after such publication, on, to-wit, the 18th day of January A. D. 1916.

The question being upon the adoption of such motion, the roll was called, with the following result: Those voting aye: Commissioners Cherrington, Vorbeck, Blackstone and Holmburg. Those voting nay: None.

All the members of the City Council present having voted in favor of said motion, the Mayor declared said motion carried and said ordinance was ordered published in accordance with said motion.

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, the Council then adjourned.
