The motion carried and the proposed ordinance was then read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Blackstone that the proposed ordinance as read and entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Moving Picture Shows," be passed and adopted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the proposed ordinance passed and adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the ordinance just passed be numbered 247.

The motion carried and it was so ordered.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council adjourned.
