

Grand Junction, Colorado  
May 23, 1916

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Rankin, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of May 16th were read and approved.

Mr. Lewis appeared before the Council and asked for rebate on water rental paid on Mrs. Cuthbert's house at 727 White avenue, owing to over-rating of said property.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the matter was referred to the Commissioner of Water and Sewers, with power to act.

S. R. Veils made application for license to do concrete sidewalk work in the city.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that a license be granted to Mr. Veils to do concrete work, upon his filing with the Clerk of an approved bond.

The motion carried by a unanimous vote of the Council.

The bill of E. R. Romberg (#21,922) for \$34.00 for preparing map of the city, having been approved by the Commissioner of Public Affairs, it was moved by Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the said bill be allowed and a warrant ordered drawn on the General Fund for the amount.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the bill allowed.

The proof of publication of a proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Establishing New Names for the Several Parks belonging to the City of Grand Junction," was presented and read.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the proof of publication was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the proposed ordinance be taken up for final passage.

The motion carried, and the proposed ordinance was then read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the proposed ordinance as read be passed and adopted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the ordinance just passed be numbered 249.

The motion carried and it was so ordered.

Bids for constructing a concrete sidewalk on the north side of Emerson Park were opened and read, as follows:

S. R. Voils, bid 10 1-4 cts. per square foot.  
Edward Johnson, bid 10 3-4 cts. per square foot.  
H. A. Polker, bid 10 1-2 cts. per square foot.

Moved by Commissioner Blackstone, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the lowest bid be accepted and that the work of constructing the sidewalk be given to S. R. Veils, provided it shall be constructed according to specifications of one and four mixture.

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called, voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the Council then adjourned.
