

Grand Junction, Colorado, September 26, 1916.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Rankin, Vorbeck, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioner Blackstone.

The minutes of the regular meeting of September 19 and adjourned session of September 20 were read and approved.

The labor account of the Department of Water and Sewers for \$21.50 (#22,612-618) having been approved by the Commissioner of Water and Sewers and audited, it was moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the same be allowed and warrants ordered drawn for the amount.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the labor account allowed.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the Council adjourned until Saturday, September 30, at 3 o'clock p. m.
