

Grand Junction, Colorado, December 26, 1916.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Rankin, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of December 19th were read and approved.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, that the Council appropriate out of the General Fund \$15.00 for maintenance of the State Labor Bureau to the close of the current year.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council adjourned until Saturday, December 30, at four o'clock p. m.
