

Grand Junction, Colorado
March 13, 1917

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Commissioner Rankin, acting Mayor, in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Rankin, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioner Cherrington.

The minutes of the regular meeting of March 6th were read and approved.

The petition of the Home Manufacturing and Investment Co. and other property owners on south avenue between Seventh and Ninth streets, asking to be left out of proposed sidewalk district, was presented and read.

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, the petition was ordered placed on file.

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, the Council adjourned until Friday, March 16, at four o'clock p. m.
