

Grand Junction, Colorado  
March 22, 1917

Pursuant to adjournment, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction met at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Commissioner Rankin, acting Mayor, presiding.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Rankin, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioner Cherrington.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be authorized and instructed to advertise for bids for furnishing the city with 3,000 barrels of standard cement, more or less, for the construction of sidewalk under proposed Sidewalk District No. 2 and also for proposed repairs of city reservoirs, bids to be subject to the completion of the proposed district.

The motion carried by a unanimous vote of the Commissioners present.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council adjourned until to-morrow, March 23d, at 10 o'clock a. m.
