

Grand Junction, Colorado
March 27, 1917

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Rankin, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg.

The minutes of the regular meeting of March 20th, and adjourned sessions of March 22d, 23d and 26th were read and approved.

Moved by Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be authorized and instructed to order six tanks of chlorine for the water department.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be authorized and instructed to order 1200 feet; more or loss, of 3-4 galvanized iron pipe for extension of water lines in city parks.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council adjourned.
