Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the bid of the Castell Lumber Co. be accepted and that a contract be entered into with said firm, subject to the formation of Sidewalk District No. 2.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows; Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea. All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council then adjourned.
