

Grand Junction, Colorado  
June 6, 1917

Pursuant to adjournment, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened at 10 o'clock a. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the bills allowed.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the Mayor and the Commissioner of Highways be authorized to close deal with Mrs. Chadwick for the purchase by the City of ten acres of gravel bed, being the north half of her 20-acre tract, for \$250.00

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioner having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

On motion of Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council adjourned.
