

Grand Junction, Colorado
June 16, 1917

All the Commissioners having been duly notified, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in special session at 9 o'clock a. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington presiding.

Upon call of roll the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Rankin, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg.

The Mayor stated that the meeting had been called for the purpose of acting on the bill of the Castell Lumber Co. for cement furnished, in order to save discount.

The bill of the Castell Lumber Co. for \$595.00 (#23,933) for 170 bbls. cement was then read by the Clerk, and the same having been approved by the Commissioner of Highways, it was moved by Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the same be allowed and a warrant ordered drawn for the amount.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea. All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the bill allowed.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the Council adjourned.
