

Grand Junction, Colorado
July 14, 1917

All the Commissioners having been duly notified, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in special session at 9 o'clock a. m., in the City Hall, with Commissioner Rankin, acting Mayor, presiding.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Rankin, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioner Cherrington.

The bill of The Castell Lumber Co. for \$847.30 (#24,255) for 2 cars cement, having been examined and approved by the Commissioner of Highways, it was moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the same be allowed and a warrant ordered drawn on the Sidewalk Dist. No. 2 Fund for the amount.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Rankin, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the bill allowed.

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council adjourned.
