

Grand Junction, Colorado
October 11, 1917

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Rankin, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the Council submit a proposition to Mr. Shores for the purchase by the City of the tract of land known as the Fair Grounds for \$2,000.00, and that the Mayor be instructed to notify Mr. Shores of this proposition.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Rankin, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council adjourned.
