

Grand Junction, Colorado
November 13, 1917

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened, pursuant to adjournment, at 10 o'clock a. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington presiding.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Rankin, Vorbeck, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioner Blackstone.

The minutes of the regular meeting of November 6th and adjourned sessions of November 7th and 8th were read and approved.

The official bonds of Commissioners--elect Cherrington and Vedder were presented and read. On motion of Commissioner Rankin, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, the said bonds were accepted subject to the approval of the City Attorney, and ordered placed on file.

The minutes of this meeting were read by the Clerk, and on motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Rankin, the same were approved as read.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that this Council now adjourn sine die.
