

Grand Junction, Colorado
November 16, 1917

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Vedder, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioners Vedder and Blackstone.

A proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Levying a Special Assessment on Certain Real Estate of Grand Junction for Benefits Conferred by the Water System of said City," was introduced and read.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the proposed ordinance as read be passed for publication.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the proposed ordinance passed for publication.

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, the Council adjourned.
