

Grand Junction, Colorado
December 11, 1917

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Vedder, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of December 4th were read and approved.

The following reports having been examined by the Auditor and the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies, it was moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the same be accepted and placed on file:

Quarterly Report of the Commissioner of Public Affairs,
Quarterly Report of the Commissioner of Water and Sewers,
Quarterly Report of the City Treasurer,
Quarterly Report of the Commissioner of Health and Civic Beauty,
Quarterly Report of the City Clerk and Auditor,
Quarterly Report of the Judge of the Municipal Court.

The motion carried.

The proof of publication of a proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Salaries," was presented and read.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the proof of publication be accepted and placed on file.

The motion carried.

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, the proposed ordinance was then taken up for final passage, and read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the proposed ordinance as read be passed and adopted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance passed and adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the ordinance just passed be numbered 261.

The motion carried, and it was so ordered.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the Mayor and Clerk be authorized and instructed to sign on behalf of the City the renewal of the contract with A. O. Shaff for the collection and disposal of garbage for two years or to November 1, 1919.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the following resolution be passed and adopted:

WHEREAS, warrant No. 25,155 for \$25.00, dated November 30, 1917, issued to A. L. Halligan for his November salary, has been lost or destroyed, be it

RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Clerk be authorized and instructed to issue another warrant for the amount of \$25.00 in lieu of said lost or destroyed warrant and that payment be ordered stopped on said warrant No. 25,155.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the resolution passed and adopted.

On motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council adjourned until Saturday, December 15, at 9 o'clock a. m.
