## Grand Junction, Colorado December 15, 1917

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session at 9 o'clock a. m., in the City Hall, with Commissioner Vedder, acting Mayor, in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Vedder, Vorbeck, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioners Cherrington and Blackstone.

The proof of publication of a proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Approving the Whole Cost of the Improvements made in and for Sidewalk District No. 2, in the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, pursuant to Ordinance No. 178, adopted and approved June 11, 1910, as amended, and pursuant to the Resolutions and Proceedings of the City Council, adopted pursuant to said Ordinance Number 178 as amended, approving the apportionment of said Costs to each Lot or Tract of Land in said District, Assessing the share of said Cost against each Lot or Tract of Land in said District, and Prescribing the Manner for the Collection and Payment of said Assessment," was presented and read.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the proof of publication be accepted and ordered placed on file.

The motion carried and the proposed ordinance was then, on motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, taken up for final passage, being read by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the prosed ordinance as red and entitled, "An Ordinance Approving the whole Cost of the Improvements made in and for Sidewalk District No.2, in the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, pursuant to Ordinance No. 178, adopted and approved June 11, 1910, as amended, and pursuant to the Resolutions and Proceedings of the City Council, adopted pursuant to said Ordinance Number 178, as amended, approving the Apportionment of said Costs to each Lot or Tract of Land in said District, Assessing the share of said Cost against each Lot or Tract of Land in said District, and Prescribing the Manner for the Collection and Payment of said Assessment," be passed and adopted, and that this ordinance be numbered 262.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the ordinance passed and adopted and numbered 262.

On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the Council adjourned.
