

Grand Junction, Colorado
January 19, 1918

All the Commissioners having been duly notified, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in special session at 11 o'clock a. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington presiding.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present:
Cherrington, Vedder, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg.

The following bids for furnishing the city one carload of lump coal were received and opened:

Voils Coal Co.,	\$5.75	per ten, mine weight.
Independent Lumber Co.,	5.75	per ten, mine weight.
Thomas Coal Mine	6.75	per ten, mine weight.
Palisade Fuel Co.,	6.00	per ten, city scales weight.
Juanita Sales Co.,	6.50	per ten, city scales weight.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the bid of the Palisade Fuel Co. be accepted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows:
Cherrington, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

On motion of Commissioner Blackstone, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, the Council adjourned.
