

Grand Junction, Colorado
March 1, 1918

All the Commissioners having been duly notified, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in special session at ten o'clock a. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington presiding.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present:
Cherrington, Vedder, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be instructed to receive bids for furnishing the City Water Department with 900 sacks of cement, more or less.

The motion carried by a unanimous vote of the Council.

Bids were then received and opened as follows:

Gibson Lumber Co., bid \$3.90 per bbl.
Castell Lumber Co., bid \$3.80 per bbl.
Independent Lumber Co., bid 95 cents gross per sack.
Ellison Lumber Co., bid \$3.87 per bbl.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the bid of the Castell Lumber Co., being the lowest, be accepted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows:
Cherrington, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

On motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council adjourned.
