George W. Fletcher having made application for renewal of plumbers' license, it was moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the license be granted, subject to the approval of the proper bond.

The motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the City Health Officer be instructed to take steps to vaccinate all the school children of the city.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

On motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council adjourned.
