Resolution.

Whereas,

It appears that the City Council has heretofore granted a license for the month of August to Harry Annheier to conduct a shooting gallery in the city of Grand Junction, and

Whereas

It appears that the shooting gallery as constructed and conducted is unsafe and dangerous, be it therefore

Resolved

that the license as granted to said Harry Annheier be and the same is hereby revoked, and be it further

Resolved

that the City Treasurer be authorized hereby to refund to the said Harry Annheier pro rata amount of his license fee for the unexpired time for which said license was paid for.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, that the resolution as read be passed and adopted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vedder, yea; Blackstone, yea; Vorbeck, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried, and the resolution passed and adopted.

The Council then adjourned.
