

Grand Junction, Colorado
September 24, 1918

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present:
Cherrington, Vedder, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg.

The minutes of the regular meeting of September 17 were read and approved.

In order to provide better fire protection for the city, Mayor Cherrington recommended the purchase of a tripple combination hose and pump truck. No action was taken by the Council.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the Council adjourn until to-morrow, September 25th, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The motion carried and the Council adjourned to said date.
