

Grand Junction, Colorado
October 22, 1918

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present:
Cherrington, Vedder, Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of October 15 were read and approved.

The petition of S. A. Waldroup and others, asking the Council to condemn the building situated on Lots 31 and 32, Block 41, in the city of Grand Junction, was presented and read.

The petition of J. S. Hynes and other members of the Fire Department, asking for an increase in salaries, was presented and read.

Both petitions were ordered filed.

A communication from Ocee O. Fellows, Assessor of Mesa County, certifying that the total assessed valuation of the City of Grand Junction, for the year 1918, is \$7,087,719.

The communication was ordered filed.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that Tuesday, October 29, be fixed by the Council as the day and date for the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies for submitting the annual general city estimate for the next fiscal year.

The motion carried.

The following resolution was introduced and read:

Resolution.

Whereas

For the past five years the city of Grand Junction has been supplying domestic water to the Oasis Mutual Water Company on Orchard Mesa; and

Whereas

during all this period the said Oasis Mutual Water Co, has been in arrears in their account with the city for such service, and at this date is in arrears to the amount of \$281.35 which is for water furnished from March 1st. 1918 to Oct. 1st. Be it therefore

Resolved

by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction that demand be made of said

Oasis Mutual Water Co. for immediate settlement in full for said balance of \$281.35, and be it further

Resolved

that if said account is not paid in full by November 15th. next, the water service to said Oasis Mutual Water Co. be shut off by the Commissioner of Water & Sewers and not turned on again until payment in full has been made for account due.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vdder, that the resolution as read be passed and adopted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was, declared carried, and the resolution passed and adopted.

On motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council adjourned.
