

Grand Junction, Colorado
November 15, 1918

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened, pursuant to adjournment, at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall.

The Mayor being absent, the meeting was called to order by the Clerk.

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, Commissioner Vorbeck was chosen president pro tem.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Vorbeck, Blackstone, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioners Cherrington and Vedder.

A quorum being present, the Council proceeded to business.

A proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Salaries," was introduced and read.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the proposed ordinance as read be passed for publication.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the proposed ordinance passed for publication.

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council adjourned.
