Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the Council appropriate \$100.00 out of the General Fund for the care of the Orchard Mesa Cemeteries for this year.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Garber, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

The monthly report of the City Weigher having been examined and approved by the Mayor, the same was on motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, accepted and ordered placed on file.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be

authorized and instructed to order 750 feet of 5-8 inch garden hose, at 16 cents per foot, for use of the Park department.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Garber, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

The Mayor recommended the appointment of F. J. Gilley as Assistant Chief of the Fire Department.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the recommendation of the Mayor be concurred in by the Council, and that F. J. Gilley be appointed as Assistant Chief of the Fire Department.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Blackstone, yea; Garber, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried, and F. J. Gilley duly appointed Assistant Fire Chief.

On motion of Commissioner Garber, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the Council adjourned.
