

Grand Junction, Colorado, April 8, 1919.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Cherrington, Blackstone, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioners Vorbeck and Garber.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of April 1 were read and approved.

A proposed ordinance, entitled "An Ordinance Providing for the Licensing of Second Hand Stores," was introduced and read.

Moved by Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the proposed ordinance as read be passed for publication.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the proposed ordinance passed for publication.

On motion of Commissioner Blackstone, seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, the Council adjourned.
