

Grand Junction, Colorado, March 16, 1920.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session at four o'clock p. m., in the City Hall, with Commissioner Garber, acting Mayor, in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Garber, Whittaker, Blackstone, Holmburg. Absent: Commissioner Cherrington.

City Attorney Tupper was present.

The minutes of the regular meeting of March 9th and adjourned session of March 13 were read and approved.

A communication from the School Board of District No. 1 with reference to exchange of properties was read, and on motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the communication was ordered placed on file.

Moved by Commissioner Whittaker, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, that the Commissioner of Water and Sewers, acting Mayor, and the City Clerk be authorized and instructed to sign the contract with the U. S. Government on behalf of the City for furnishing water for the Federal Building for the next year at a water rental of \$96.00 per year, payable quarterly.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Garber, yea; Whittaker, yea; Blackstone, yea; Holmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.
