

Grand Junction Colorado, Sept. 21, 1920.

The minutes of Sept. 14, was read and approved.

The application by the Richardson Drug Co. was read and upon motion by Commissioner Whittaker Second by Commissioner Blackstone permitting them to place an Electric Sign in front of their place of business, all Commissioners present voting yea the motion was declared carried and permit granted.

The monthly report of the City weigher having been approved by the Mayor was ordered filed.

A communication from Messers Haynes and Spaid requesting the City to assist them in haveing the Light Co. extend their line to their home on East Ute Ave. The communication was turned over to the Mayor to use his influence in their behalf.
