

Grand Junction, Colo. Oct.13th. 1920

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction meet in regular session with Cherrington in the chair, Commissioners present Blackstone, Garber, Whittaker.

The minutes of Sept.28 was read also the minutes of Oct. 5th and 7th. was read and approved. City attorney Tupper was present.

Moved by Commissioner Blackstone, second by Commissioner Garber that we turn over to the County treasurer the new water assessment book to make up at a cost of (\$50.00) Upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows Cherrington yea, Garber yea, Blackstone yea, Whittaker yea, all Commissioners voting yea the motion was declared carried.

The proof of publication of proposed ordinance entitled "an ordinance amending portions of Ordinance No.178 of the City of Grand Junction, Colo. passed June 11, 1910 and also amending Ordinance No.208 of said City passed March 4, 1913," was presented and read.

On motion of Commissioner Blackstone, seconded by Commissioner Garber the proof of publication was accepted and ordered placed on file. motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Whittaker, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone that the proposed ordinance be taken up for final passage. The motion carried and the proposed ordinance was then read by the Acting Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Blackstone, seconded by Commissioner Garber that the proposed ordinance as read and entitled "an ordinance amending portions of Ordinance No.178 of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado passed June 11, 1910 and also amending Ordinance No.208 of said City passed March 4, 1913. "be passed and adopted and that the same be numbered No.294.

The motion being put upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington yea, Garber yea, Blackstone yea, Whittaker yea, all the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried and the ordinance passed and adopted and numbered No. 294.

The report of the City Weigher for the Third Quarter having been approved by the Mayor was read. Moved by Commissioner Whittaker seconded by Commissioner Blackstone, the report be accepted and placed on file. Motion carried.

Tom Tabner appeared before the Council regarding the leasing of Palmer Park he was advised to look into the propposition more fully and come in next Meeting. The following bills having been approved by heads of depts. was read by the clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Whittaker seconded by Commissioner Blackstone that the Commissioner of Water & Sewers request repairs to put the City digger in good working order and that the Commissioner of finance & Supplies be authorized to order such repairs. Motion being put upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows Cherrington yea, Garber yea, Blackstone yea, Whittaker yea, all Commissioners yea the motion was declared carried, and the supplies ordered.

Moved by Commissioner Whittaker seconded by Commissioner Blackstone to adjourn the meeting till Friday Oct.15. at 4 o'clock P.M. Motion carried.
