The adjourned meeting of October 26, was called to order at 9 O'clock A.M. with Mayor Cherrington in the chair, Commissioners present, Cherrington, Garber, Blackstone, Whittaker, City Attorney Tupper was present.

The Mayor presented the statement of material required for the with was lighting it was moved by Commissioner Cherrington, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone that the Commissioner of Finance & Supplies be instructed to order Posts and Supplies for said white way the approximate cost being \$3,835.00 of which amount the property owners along said white way have donated half the amount the motion being put upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows Cherrington yea, Garber yea, Blackstone yea, Whittaker yea, all Commissioners voting yea the motion was declared carried and the material ordered.

The report of the City Clerk & Auditor for the third quarter was read and on motion by Commissioner Blackstone seconded by Commissioner Garber the report was accepted and filed the motion carried. the reports of the several commissioners for the 1921 budget were presented and read and turned over to the Commissioner of Finance & Supplies to figure the levy for the coming taxes there being no further business to come before the meeting it was moved by Commissioner Whittaker seconded by Commissioner Blackstone that the meeting adjourn, motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
