

Grand Junction, Colo. Nov. 23, 1920.

The regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction was called to order at 3:30 o'clock P.M. with Mayor Cherrington in the chair, Commissioners present Cherrington, Garber, Blackstone, Whittaker, City Attorney Tupper was present. The minutes of Nov. 16, 1920 was read and approved.

Commissioner Whittaker read the names of the different people on the Kannah Creek pipe line whom are using water and are not paying for the same,

Moved by Commissioner seconded by Commissioner Garber that the City Attorney draft a letter same to be signed by the Mayor notifying the following persons I. H. Davison, Wm. A. Lynch, J. W. Cox, Chas. Kerstetter, Chas. Ashley, Traynor, Eugene Spencer, W. C. Smith (Buford Place) Cosgrove Estate, that unless water is paid for same will be shut off and tap plugged, Motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Blackstone seconded by Commissioner Garber the Commissioner of Finance & Supplies be instructed to purchas one steel filing cabinet for use of the City Physician, the motion being put upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington yea, Garber yea, Blackstone yea, Whittaker yea, all the Commissioners voting yea the motion was declared carried.

The communication from the State Compensation Insurance Fund was read and ordered filed.
