

Grand Junction, Colorado, Dec.7th.1920.

The regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction was called to order at 3 o'clock P.M. with Mayor Cherrington in the chair, Commissioners present Cherrington, Garber, Blackstone, Whittaker, City Attorney Tupper was present.

The Minutes of the regular meeting of Nov.30th was read and approved.

The question of the inspection of buildings reported by J.S. Hynes on April 13, was brought up and the Mayor agreed to report at the next meeting.

Moved by Commissioner Garber seconded by Commissioner Blackstone that the Commissioners of water & Sewers and Finance & Supplies make an inspection of the Business district regarding Water rates, Motion carried.
