

Grand Junction, Colorado December 31st 1920

The Adjourned meeting of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction was called to order at 5 O'clock P.M. with Mayor Cherrington in the chair. Commissioners present were Cherrington, Garber, Blackstone, Whittaker. City Attorney was present.

There was some discussion regarding the City Clerkship and it was decided that if a suitable man could not be secured to take Mr. Holmburgs place that a clerk be hired as City Clerk. No motions were made.

The bill in favor of School Dist. No. 1 for \$2,875.00 to cover the transfer of the Blocks as per Ordinance No. 9 was read and it was moved that the bill be allowed and a warrant be drawn April 1, 1921 for the same.
