

Grand Junction, Colo., Jan. 11 1921

The regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction was called to order at 3:30 O'clock P.M. with Mayor Cherrington in the chair. Commissioners present: Cherrington, Garber, Whittaker, Blackstone. City Attorney Tupper came in late.

The minutes of January 4th 1921 were read and approved.

The Mayor recommended that an arc-light be placed at the corner of South Seventh and Pitkin Ave. Moved by Commissioner Garber, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone that the Mayor instruct the Light Company to install an arc-light at the corner of South Seventh and Pitkin Ave. Motion Carried.

Moved by Mayor Cherrington, seconded by Commissioner Whittaker; that Fred A. Peck be appointed to the office of Commissioner of Health and Civic Beauty, ex-officio City Clerk and that be instructed to furnish a two-thousand dollar bond, the City to pay premium on same. This appointment is made to fill the place vacated by Chas. K. Holmburg some months ago. The motion being put upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington, "yea"; Garber, "yea"; Blackstone, "yea"; Whittaker "yea". All the Commissioners voting "yea", the motion was declared carried and the appointment confirmed.

The contract for Liquid Chlorine was read. Moved by Commissioner Garber, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone that the contract be executed and that the shipping instructions be as follows: Two (2) one hundred pound tanks shipped June first; and two (2) one hundred pound tanks shipped August first. Upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows: Cherrington "yea"; Garber "yea", Blackstone "yea", Whittaker "yea", all the Commissioners voting "yea" the motion was declared carried and the contract signed.

The following bills having been examined and approved by the heads of the different departments were read by the clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Garber, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
