Grand Junction Colo. January 25, 1921

The regular meeting of the City Council of Grand Junction Colorado was called to order at 3:15 P.M. with Mayor Cherrington in the chair.

The Commissioners present were Cherrington, Garber, Whittaker and Peck. Commissioner Blackstone was absent. City Attorney Tupper was not present.

The minutes of the last regular session were read and approved.

Moved by Commissioner Whittaker, second by Commissioner Garber that the following reports which had been OKed by the City Auditor be accepted and filed. That of the Highways Department, Water and Sewers Department, Public Affairs Department, and that of the Judge of the Municipal Court. Motion carried. Moved by Commissioner Whittaker, second by Commissioner Garber that the reports of the Commissioner of Health and Civic Beauty and that of the City Clerk and Auditor having been OKed by the City Treasurer be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

A proposed ordinance concerning the salaries of certain city employees was introduced and read. Moved by Commissioner Cherrington, second by Commissioner Whittaker that the proposed ordinance be passed for publication as read. The motion being put upon call of roll the Commissioners present voted as follows; Cherrington, yea, Garber, yea, Whittaker, yea, Peck, yea. All the Commissioners present having voted yea the motion was declared carried and the proposed ordinance passed for publication.

Fred A Peck duly appointed Commissioner of Health and Civic Beauty took the oath of office. Mayor Cherrington administered the oath. Moved by Commissioner Garber, second by Commissioner Whittaker that the official bond of Fred A Peck be accepted for approval. Motion carried.

The official bond of Dixon and Watson master plumbers having been approved by City Attorney Tupper was accepted and ordered filed. The official bond of John Fuite plumber, having been approved by City Attorney Tupper was accepted and ordered filed.

Moved by Commissioner Whittaker second by Commissioner Garber that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.
