

Grand Junction, Colo.
April 5, 1921

The regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colo., convened in regular session at 3:30 P.M. with Mayor Cherrington presiding. The commissioners present were, Cherrington, Garber, Whittaker, Blackstone and Peck. City Attorney Tupper was also present.

The minutes of the last regular session were read and approved.

A petition signed by taxpayers requesting that a light be installed on the corner of 6th and Belford was presented. Moved by Commissioner Peck, seconded by Commissioner Garber; that the light, be installed upon the Mayors recommendation. Motion carried.

Communications from the Graham⁶ Jones Motor Co. and from the Boller Auto Co., in reference to motor sprinklers were read. The matter was laid on the table for further investigation.

A.E.Anderson representing the Grand Junction Electric, Gas and Mfg. Co., appeared before the meeting asking that the city cooperate with him in replacing the curbs where it had been necessary to tear up the same for the placing of conduits for the white way. Mr. Anderson was assured that the city would render the assistance asked for.

Commissioner Blackstone was instructed to place "Stop" signs near the public school buildings as a safety first measure.
