

Grand Junction, Colo.
April 26, 1921.

A regular meeting of the City Council convened at 3:30 P.M. with Mayor Cherrington presiding. The Commissioners present were, Cherrington, Garber, Whittaker, Blackstone and Peck. City Attorney Tupper was also present.

The minutes of the last regular session were read and approved.

A petition signed by James Purcell was read requesting a permit to move the building standing on Lot One (1) in Block 125 in the City of Grand Junction, to the adjoining lot, being Lot Two (2) of Block 123. Said James Purcell agrees to brick veneer the said wooden building when located on Lot 2, on the Northwest and South sides., and to raise the brick wall between the building now on Lot 3 and the said building for fire protection on the East side of the building as moved. Moved by Commissioner Whittaker, second by Commissioner Blackstone that a permit be given James Purcell on condition of the facts mentioned above. The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows, Cherrington, yea; Garber, yea; Whittaker, yea; Blackstone, yea; Peck, yea. All the Commissioners voting yea, the motion was declared carried.

Moved by Commissioner Garber, seconded by Commissioner Blackstone that an arc light be installed at the intersection of 12st. and Ute Ave. Said light having been recommended by the Mayor. Motion carried.

A petition was read signed by Mrs. C.P. Blackwell and others urging the City of Grand Junction to procure a certain piece of land lying directly east of the tract whereon the Artesian well is located, said tract to be used by the City for park and cemetery purposes and secure release from the Palmer estate on the present Palmer Park so as to read for Park and Cemetery purposes. Upon motion of Commissioner Peck, second by Commissioner Blackstone, a committee consisting of the Mayor and City Attorney a was appointed by the chair to see what arrangements could be made with the Palmer Estate in securing this certain tract.

The report of the Commissioner of Public Affairs for the first quarter was read. Moved by Commissioner Peck, second by Commissioner Blackstone that the report be referred to the Clerk and Auditor for Audit. Motion carried.

The reports of the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies, Commissioner of Highways, Commissioner of Water and Sewers, having been examined and Oked by the Auditor were presented. Moved by Commissioner Whittaker second by Commissioner Peck that the reports be accepted and ordered filed. Motion carried.

The reports of the City Clerk and Auditor and the report of the Commissioner of Health and Civic Beauty having been examined by and OK ed by the City Treasurer were presented. Moved by Commissioner Whittaker, second by Commissioner Blackstone that the reports be accepted and ordered filed. Motion Carried.

Moved by Commissioner Whittaker second by Commissioner Garber that the Commissioner Of Finance and Supplies be authorized and instructed to purchase the following supplies for the Fire Department. to-wit:

500 feet Red Cross fire hose @ \$1.30 per foot, f.c.b. Grand Jct.

One hydrant siamese gate @ \$65.00.

One gal. polish @ \$2.00

The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows, Cherrington, yea; Garber, yea; Whittaker, yea; Blackstone, yea; Peck, yea. All the Commissioners voting yea, the motion was declared carried.
