

Grand Junction, Colo.  
August 2, 1921

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular session at 4:00 P.M. with Mayor Cherrington presiding. The Commissioners present were, Cherrington, Garber, Blackstone and Peck. City attorney Tupper was absent.

The minutes of the last regular meeting and of the special meeting held July 30 were read and approved.

The application of C.P. Bliss for the position of Finance and Supplies was presented and read. Moved by Commissioner Peck, second by Commissioner Garber that the application be accepted and filed for future reference. Motion carried.

The request of R.B. Tourner asking that he be exempted from paying his donation for the river protection work on the grounds that he had sold his place was taken up for consideration. Moved by Commissioner Garber second by Commissioner Peck that the matter be referred to the City Attorney. Motion carried.
